Dear Parents and Community Members,

There was a reported "Stranger Danger" by one of our male middle school students this morning, Wednesday, May 11, 2011. The incident occurred at approximately 8:40 a.m. while the student was walking to school around Midway and Kinloch Roads.

The student reported he was being followed by a white, two-door Nissan with flip-up headlights. The driver was a white male, mid to upper thirties, light brown hair, a goatee, and wearing a blue t-shirt. The person in the Nissan never approached or had any type of communication with our student, but proceeded to follow him to the corner of Norborne and Warren Road, just before Custard Hut.

The Dearborn Heights Police Department has been notified of this incident and will be watching the area for the next few days.

Those of us who live, work, or go to school in Dearborn Heights appreciate the low crime rate in our community, but we must be aware that there is a potential for criminal activity, even in the safest communities. Please remind your children not to talk to strangers, to be aware of their surroundings and to report any suspicious activity. Working together, we can keep our students and community safe.

Parents, if you witness any suspicious behaviors occurring in your neighborhood and around your child's bus stop, do not hesitate to contact 9-1-1 and report the incident.
